June 6, 1933


First drive-in movie theater opens in Camden, NJ





The Great Judging Debate

The pandemic changed a great deal of our everyday lives, as well as affecting our hobby. Supply chain issues affect acquisition of trophies and awards, and loss of business and workers has hurt our abilities to get sponsorship for clubs and events. It's also affected the way we judge car shows.

Volunteers and judges are not readily available as they once were. This is forcing many organizations to switch to people, or peer choice judging.

There will always be the "why didn't I win a trophy and he did" complaint. We just can't seem to avoid it. But which form of judging is the most fair? The only way to guarantee complete neutrality is to hire a group of judges from out of the area to come and judge the event. For many clubs and organizations, this is totally cost prohibitive. In the end, spending extra money means less goes to the charity you are trying to help. This means that we'll just have to accept and live with a little unavoidable bias.

Sure, people and clubs come to a show in groups, and may vote for each others cars in a peer choice setting. There's nothing that can be done as long as the votes are tallied fairly. It's also possible local judges prefer one type of car over another, or aren't properly taught how to judge. We just need to remember why we are there - to have fun and show our rides to the community! No one wins at every show. Make sure to show your support for the winners no matter what happens - one day, that winner might be you!

JUDGED SHOWS

A team of judges examine each vehicle and awards are based on points. At certain shows, vehicles can lose points for alterations from stock.



PEOPLES CHOICE

Show participants and spectators cast their vote for vehicle(s) they'd like to see win.
