A RARE FORD XL MOVES TO NEW JERSEY

For our friend Peter, it was love at first sight with this 1969 Ford XL Convertible. So much so, he had it shipped from its original home in West Virginia to New Jersey. But it wasn't until he received his Marti Report on the car that he realized just how rare it is. To start, this vehicle was built 11 days ahead of schedule on May 20, 1969. It was one of only five made with it's particular paint and trim codes, and only one of 183 painted by the factory in Oxford Gray. It's powered by the original 429 V8 and C6 automatic transmission. It's finished off with a white convertible top and red interior and bench seat.

The car runs like new and is a blast to drive! The 429 V8 puts out 360hp and 480 lbs-ft of torque. Even though this is a big car weighing in at around 3,600 lbs with a 121 inch wheelbase, you can still spin the wheels and do some cool burnouts. In reality, it's a muscle car disguised as a luxury vehicle.

This ride is certainly a head turner with the beautiful Oxford Gray paint shining in the sun. When it was delivered there was even a best paint trophy in the trunk from a show in West Virginia.
